

TERMS & CONDITIONS FOR PARTICIPATION IN ASTRO KEM BOLA CLUB 2018

1. ORGANISERS

- I. The organiser of Astro Kem Bola Club 2018 ("Astro Kem Bola Club 2018" or "Programme") is YAYASAN ASTRO KASIH ("Organiser")
- II. Any inquiries regarding Astro Kem Bola Club 2018 may be channeled to the Organiser via the Feedback section in www.astrokasih.org/kembola.

2. REGISTRATION AND RELEASE

- I. With the submission of the official Registration Form and Liability Release Statement (collectively the "Forms") of Astro Kem Bola Club 2018 to the Organiser, it is presumed that the participants and their parents/guardians:
 - Agree to abide by all the conditions of participation set out in these Forms.
 - Consent to all the terms contained in the "Privacy Policy" (if applicable) and "Privacy Notice" which may be found on line at: <http://www.astro.com.my/portal/privacy-policy-2/> and <http://www.astro.com.my/portal/privacy-notice/> respectively.
 - Represent to the Organiser that the participants are in a fit and healthy condition to participate in this physically intensive selection camp.

3. PARTICIPATION

- I. Astro Kem Bola Club 2018 is open to all Malaysians under the ages of 10 to 12 years in 2018 (born between 1 January 2006 and 31 December 2008) and who possess a valid Malaysian identity card.
- II. The number of participants is limited for each training camp venue. Submission of the Forms does not guarantee any candidate the opportunity to participate in Astro Kem Bola Club 2018. The Organiser shall be entitled to reject or refuse participation by any person for any reason, including (without limitation) where the Forms are not complete, illegible or any provisions in the Terms and Conditions are not fulfilled or adhered to by the person.
- III. The Forms can be accessed at www.astrokasih.org/kembola.
- IV. Application for registration or participation through the phone will not be accepted.
- V. Priority will be given to candidates who submit completed forms at www.astrokasih.org/kembola online before the respective closing dates as provided in clause 4 (I) below.
- VI. The Organiser will not be responsible or liable for any problem, loss or damage of whatsoever nature suffered by any person due to any delay and/or failure in receiving and sending the Forms as a result of any network, communication, ISP or system error, interruption and/or failure experienced by the Organiser or the person's telecommunication service provider and/or resulting from participation or the downloading of any materials in the Programme. In the event of such error, interruption and/or failure, the Organiser shall not be responsible or liable for any failure encountered by any person to participate in the Programme or any failure encountered by the Organiser in fulfilling its obligations hereunder.
- VII. Previous Astro Kem Bola participants that have participated in any Astro Program held in previous years are not eligible to participate in Astro Kem Bola Club 2018.

4. DATES, TIMES AND LOCATIONS

- I. The date, time and location for each training camp will be stated on the registration website www.astrokasih.org/kembola.
- II. All selected participants must be present for all training sessions. Any participant who fails without reasonable cause to attend any training session, will not be considered for further training in Malaysia or abroad.
- III. All selected participants acknowledge that the final training session will be held - at a location to be determined by the Organiser. If the final training session is held outside Malaysia, each selected participant for this final training session must hold a valid passport with at least six (6) months' validity period. It shall be the responsibility of such participants to obtain the necessary visas and other travel documents at their sole cost and expense. No compensation whatsoever will be given by the Organiser should the participants fail to obtain such documents, regardless of the circumstances.
- IV. Passport control and in-country authorities reserve the right to refuse entry into any country being visited. If any of the participants is refused passage, entry or exit to or from the country being visited, the Organiser will not be responsible in any way to compensate the said participant for such refusal of passage, entry or exit and any additional costs incurred will be at the sole cost and responsibility of the participant.

5. COACHES

- I. Training at Astro Kem Bola Club 2018 will be conducted by qualified coaches or any other persons as determined by the Organiser.
- II. Decisions of the coaches are final and no correspondence shall be entered into regarding selection of participants for any phase of the program.

6. PLAYER'S CLOTHING

- I. All participants must wear the T-shirts or jerseys provided by the Organiser throughout Astro Kem Bola Club 2018.
- II. Participants are required to wear their own nylon socks, shin guards and football boots throughout their participation in Astro Kem Bola Club 2018 training sessions. Other than official t-shirts or jerseys, the Organisers shall not be responsible for supplying any other item of clothing to the participants.
- III. Participants must ensure that their attire is always neat and clean before each Astro Kem Bola Club 2018 training session.

7. SAFETY

- I. Although all precautions will be undertaken by the Organiser throughout the Programme, participants are ultimately responsible for their own safety. The participants acknowledge that his/her participation in the Programme is at his/her sole risk. The Organiser shall not be responsible if there is any injury, disability or loss of life during the Programme.
- II. The Organiser reserves the sole right to prohibit and disqualify any participant from Astro Kem Bola Club 2018 if it appears that participants in a state of poor physical health.
- III. Briefings will be made by the Organiser and Astro Kem Bola Club 2018 coaches regarding safety measures during the training sessions. However, in the event of an accident occurring during the training sessions, the Organiser will provide reasonable medical assistance to affected participants.

8. DISCIPLINE

- I. All participants shall give due respect to the coaches, officials and other fellow participants.
- II. Participants are prohibited from being involved in unacceptable behavior such as:
 - Fighting, or starting a fight with others, including any third parties
 - Intentionally causing serious injury to others
 - Insulting and offending others
 - Smoking, drug abuse or bringing substances that are harmful to the health of participants to the premises or training fields which the Programme is held
 - Intentionally causing damage to equipment and facilities available at the premises or training fields which the Programme is held
- III. All participants must comply with the attendance requirement set by the coaches.
- IV. The Organiser reserve the right to prohibit and remove any participant found to contravene any of the requirements specified herein or during the Programme.

9. OTHER TERMS

- I. The Organiser shall not be responsible for any loss of money or property by any participant during the Programme.
- II. The cleanliness of any venue, including all football fields and premises used for the Programme is the responsibility of all participants and must be maintained throughout the duration of the Programme.
- III. The Organiser will consider all appeals except for offences specified in clause 8 (II) above and strive to communicate the result of this appeal within two (2) weeks from the date any appeal is received.
- IV. The Organiser reserve the right at any time to modify, change, amend, delete or add to any of the terms and conditions set out in this document at its absolute discretion without prior notice.
- V. The Organiser may terminate or suspend the Programme at any time at their absolute discretion in which case, the Organiser may elect not to select any participants. Such termination or suspension shall not give rise to any claim by the participants. If the Programme is resumed by the Organiser, the participant shall abide by the Organiser's decision regarding resumption of the Programme.
- VI. The participants shall not be entitled to assign any of the rights or sub-contract any of the obligations herein. The Organiser shall be entitled to assign or sub-license the whole or any part of its rights hereunder to any third party as may be determined by the Organiser.
- VII. These Terms and Conditions of the Programme shall be construed, governed and interpreted in accordance with the laws of Malaysia.
- VIII. Participants and their parents/guardians/chaperons shall treat all Terms and Conditions and rules and regulations of the Programme and all information and knowledge obtained by the participants in relation to and/or in connection with the Programme and/or derived as a result of his/her participation in the same, including without limitation the Organiser's business and operational details, and details about the mechanics of the Programme (hereafter collectively known as "Confidential Information"), as confidential and the participants shall, during and after the Programme period, take all reasonable precautions to prevent disclosures of the Confidential Information to unauthorized persons or entities for any reason whatsoever and undertakes to deliver to the Organizers all tangible materials embodying the Confidential Information including any documentation, records, listings, notes, sketches, drawings, memoranda, models, accounts, reference materials, samples and machine readable media and equipment that is in any way related to the Confidential Information including all duplicates and copies thereof.

- IX. Unless otherwise notified by the Organiser, all costs incurred by the participants in relation to and/or with respect to the Programme including without limitation postal charges or Internet Service Provider (ISP) charges (if applicable), all transport costs, communication charges, accommodation, meal costs and other related costs incurred by the participant as a result of and/or pursuant to his/her participation in the Programme shall be solely borne by the participants. The Organiser shall not be under any obligation to reimburse the participants for any of such costs and expenses incurred thereof.
- X. The main language of the Terms and Conditions shall be the English language. Any translation to any other language than English shall be for convenience only. In the event of any inconsistency between this English language and any other languages, the English language version shall prevail and govern in all respects.
- XI. The invalidity, illegality or unenforceability of any terms hereunder shall not affect or impair the continuation in force of the remainder of the Terms and Conditions of the Programme.
- XII. All rights and privileges herein granted to the Organiser are irrevocable and not subjected to rescission, restraint or injunction under any and all circumstances. Under no circumstances shall the participants have the right to injunctive relief or to restrain or otherwise interfere with the organisation of the Programme, the production, distribution, exhibition and/or exploitation of any recording of the Programme and/or any product based on and/or derived from the Programme.
